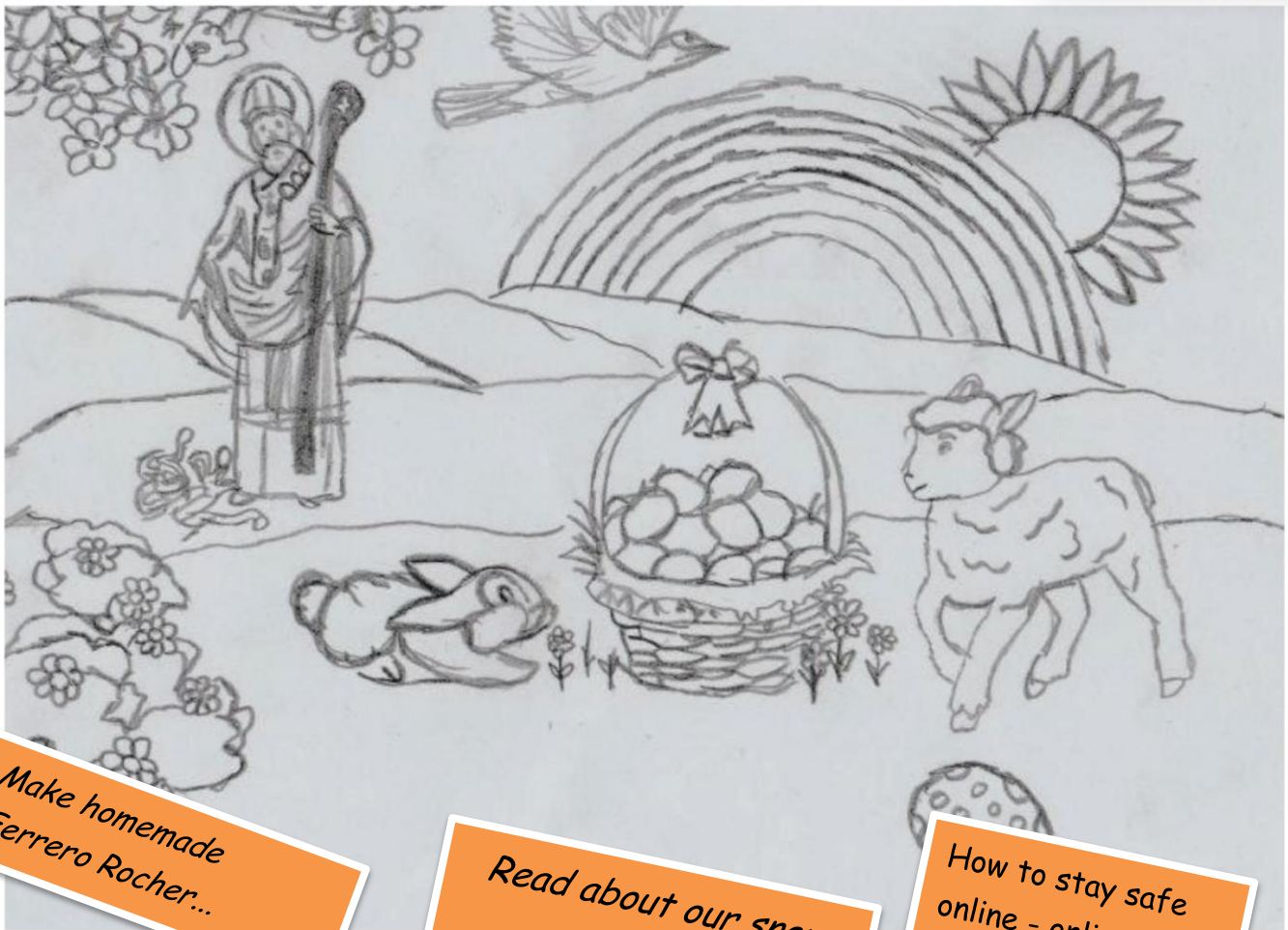

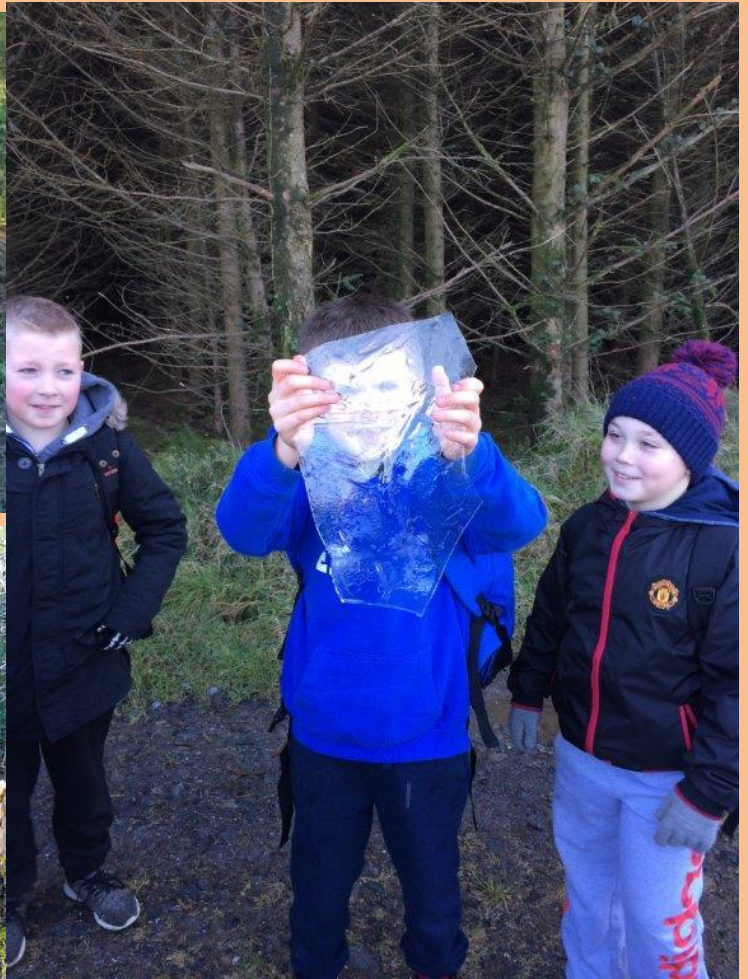

# How to protect yourself on Social Media.

### 1. Keep Your Online Identity Secret

Don't tell anyone your real name and address or what part of Waterford you live in. Here's the general rule: ***Don't give out any information that a person could possibly use to find you.*** Even "small clues" like what Waterford school you attend or the name of your hurling team are enough for a person to figure out who you are. You wouldn't tell some 40-year-old stranger in town your name and where you live, would you? So why would you tell a random Internet stranger from a chat room?

### 2. Your Username and Password Belong to You ... And Only You

Don't give your username or password to anyone. It's just that simple. What if a friend logs on Twitter, Facebook or Snapchat and pretends to be you, and then says something really awful and gets you in trouble? It might seem some crack, to the "former" friend, but it's serious and it happens every day. With your username and password, someone can post language that gets you expelled from school, in trouble with your parents, or even in trouble with the Gardai. Keep your name and password private.

### 3. The Internet has a Great Memory ... So Keep Its Memory of You Clean

Just because the Internet is so massive does not mean that embarrassing pictures, rude or mean comments, or even illegal activities will disappear forever. Watch what you post about yourself or others -- or allow your friends to post about you -- because you may have to live with it for a long, long time.

### 4. Be Good Online ... Just Like You Are Offline

Writing "hate" emails, hacking into other people's computers, illegally downloading music or films and making online threats are just as illegal on the Internet as they are in the real world. You cannot hide behind a made up name and get away with it. Watch what you write -- because someone else is watching what you write!

### 5. Be Extremely Careful about Meeting Someone in Person

This is worth remembering: ***"Never meet anyone in person that you meet online."*** That said, many young people in Ireland do make good friends online. You just have to be really careful and make sure other people you know and trust also know this "new" online person.

If you do decide to meet the new person, bring your parents with you. All of you meet together in a public area like a shopping centre where there are loads of people around. Ask that the person's parents come, too. If the situation feels not right, it probably is not right! Just like in the real world, always trust your inner feelings -- and walk away.

## 6. Your Parents or Guardians Are Ultimately Responsible for young people Online

Even if your parents don't know much about the Internet, tell them what types of web sites you go to. They will probably be interested and impressed with your Internet skills. They may also help you avoid potential problems if a web site or new "friend" begins to look suspicious.

## 7. Almost Everything on the Internet Is Traceable

Every search, web site visit, online posting and email is registered or recorded somewhere on the Internet. Once you send something out on the Internet, it's almost impossible to take it back. You have to be careful, not impulsive, when you write an email or go to chat rooms.



### *The most popular social media applications in Ireland.*

**Facebook:** Facebook is a popular social networking website that allows registered user to create profiles [your own personal page], upload photos and video, send messages to friends on Facebook and keep in touch with family, friends and relations. You have to be over 13 years of age to have a Facebook profile.

**Snapchat:** Snapchat is a mobile messaging application used to share photos, videos, text, and drawings. What makes Snapchat unique is that messages that are sent on the app disappear after a few seconds.

**Instagram:** is a free online photo application, you can take a picture with your phone, change it with a series of filters and share it with friends.

**Twitter:** is a free Internet service - registered users can post short text messages [tweets] and photos online where other people can read them.



# *Jamie's Homemade Ferrero Rocher.*

## Ingredients:

- Nutella-225g

When Charlie was young he was attacked and nearly killed by a dog...he has a permanent scar over one of his eyes from this.



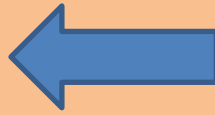
